Grant of Privilege Hauler FAQ – Revenues Subject to GOP Fee

- 1) Is hauling revenue (as defined by the agreement) subject to the fee?**
 - A. Yes
- 2) Is disposal revenue subject to the fee?**
 - A. Disposal revenue is subject to the fee when the disposal is bundled with the collection service. Example: weekly collection of a dumpster for one single price that includes collection, disposal, fees, etc.
 - B. Disposal revenue is not subject to the fee when the disposal is a separate pass-through line item on the customer invoice and the disposal is not marked up. If the disposal amount is marked up, that mark up is subject to the fee.
- 3) Are fuel surcharges subject to the fee?**
 - a. Yes
- 4) Are all line item surcharges associated with a customer’s account subject to the fee?**
 - b. Yes
- 5) Are rental fees and daily fees for dumpsters, roll-off boxes, and other collection bins subject to the fee?**
 - c. Yes
- 6) Is the City of Fort Worth Landfill Environmental Fee subject to the fee?**
 - A. No, this fee is paid at the Southeast landfill and if it is passed through to the customer on a line item, that amount is not subject to the fee.
 - B. The Landfill Environmental fee is subject to the fee if it is bundled with the collection service. Example: weekly collection of a dumpster for one single price that includes collection, disposal, fees, Landfill Environmental Fee, etc.
- 7) Are overloaded fees revenue subject to the fee?**
 - A. Yes
- 8) When are loads not subject to the fee?**
 - A. All fees charged to that customer with the exception of line item disposal will be subject to the fee. Materials collected at no charge to the customer are not subject to the fee because there was no revenue generated from the customer. Example is hauler collects and hauls recycling materials for no-charge because they try to make money from recycling the material.
